

HOW CAN I APPLY FOR THE EXCELLENCE EIFFEL PROGRAMME (MASTER'S DEGREE) AT PARIS 1 PANTHÉON-SORBONNE?

Please read carefully the programme guide before applying: [Eiffel programme](#)

► Eligibility criteria:

- to benefit from the scholarship, you have to apply to one of our Master's degrees, here are the eligible areas of study: Economics, Management, Political Science, Law, Mathematics, French history. [Here](#) is a list of our degrees. You will also find a list of the degrees either fully or partially taught in English [here](#). (Only Research or Professional Master degrees taught as « formation initiale » or « FI » are available. For IAE degrees, please get in touch directly with the [IAE](#)). You must choose a degree before applying for the scholarship.

- your diploma must grant you access to the degree you are applying to (corresponding to the French Licence to enter a 1st year of Master's degree, or corresponding to a French M1 to enter a 2nd year of Master's degree)

- be a foreign citizen (priority is given to citizens from developing countries)

- be less than 25 years old at the time of the selection (born after March 1996)

- prove a C1 level of French for degrees taught in French, prove a sufficient level of English for degrees taught in English.

- apply only once (you can not apply if your file has already been selected during a previous campaign, even if it was selected by another university or school).

- do not cumulate scholarships, you can not apply if you are already recipient of a scholarship (French government, AUF, Erasmus+, etc.).

- Candidates who are currently studying in France do not qualify for the scholarship.

► How much? 1181€/month + round trip ticket, health mutual + possible housing allowance (under some conditions).

► How long? max. 12 months for an admission in a 2nd year of Master's degree, max. 24 months for an admission in a Master's 1st and 2nd year.

► How to apply?

1. If you meet the criteria, send an email to eiffel@univ-paris1.fr, indicating precisely your nationality, your country of residence, your age, your level of study and the Master's degree you plan to pursue at Paris 1. You also need to add the documents listed below. Without this information, your demand will not be considered.

- ID (Passport)
- Detailed CV, 1 to 2 pages
- Certificate of language proficiency (according to the teaching language)
- Professional project (1 to 2 pages, explain why you chose this degree in France, in the lights of your previous studies and your plan for a future career)
- Diplomas & ranking (translated into French or English)
- Transcripts of records for the last three years of studies (translated into French or English)
- Letters of recommendation (optional but appreciated)

2. After reviewing your documents, you may receive instructions to fill in an online form.

3. The deadline for us to receive your complete file is November 17th, 2021.
