HOW CAN I APPLY FOR THE EXCELLENCE EIFFEL PROGRAM (MASTER DEGREE), AT PARIS 1 PANTHEON-SORBONNE?

Please read carefully the program guide before applying: program Eiffel

► Eligibility criteria :

- to benefit from the scholarship, you have to apply to one of our Master degrees, here are the eligible areas of study: Economics, Management, Political Science, Law. <u>Here</u> is a list of our degrees. You will also find a list of the degrees either fully or partially taught in English <u>here</u>. (Only Research or Professional Master degrees taught as « formation initiale » or « FI » are available. For IAE degrees, please get in touch directly with the <u>IAE</u>). You must choose a degree before applying for the scholarship.
- your diploma must grant you access to the degree you are applying to (corresponding to the French Licence to enter a 1st year of Master degree, or corresponding to a French M1 to enter a 2nd year of Master)
- be a foreign citizen (priority is given to citizens from developing countries)
- currently be a student in a foreign country
- be less than 30 years old
- prove a C1 level of French for degrees taught in French, prove a sufficient level of English for degrees taught in English.
- apply only once (you can not apply if your file has already been selected during a previous campaign, even if it was selected by another university or school).
- do not cumulate scholarships, you can not apply if you are already recipient of a scholarship (French government, AUF, Erasmus+, etc.).
- ► How much? 1181€/month + round trip ticket, health mutual + possible housing allowance (under some conditions).
- ► How long? max. 12 months for an admission in 2nd year of Master, max. 24 months for an admission in Master 1st and 2nd year.

► How to apply ?

- 1. If you meet the criteria, send an email to eiffel@univ-paris1.fr, indicating precisely your nationality, your country of residence, your age, your level of study and the Master degree you plan to pursue at Paris 1. You also need to add the documents listed below. Without these information, your demand will not be taken into account.
 - Detailed CV, 1 to 2 pages
 - Certificate of language proficiency (according to the teaching language)
 - Professional project (1 to 2 pages, explains why you chose this degree in France, in the lights of your previous studies and your plan for a future career)
 - Diplomas (translated to French or English)
 - Transcripts of records for the last three years of studies (translated to French or English)
 - Letters de recommendation (optional but appreciated)
 - ID (Passport)
- 2. After studying your documents, you may receive an application form (no application form will be delivered after November 12st, 2020).
- 3. The **deadline** for us to receive your complete file (application form + the additional documents) is **November 13rd, 2020**.
